Frequently Asked Questions

How do I register?

You may **mail in** your registration form so that it arrives before or on **March 1st**. If received earlier than **March 1st**, registrations are placed in same group as those received **March 1st**. **Web based registration begins on March 1st**. If you use the **Web to register**, it is your **check that holds the camp spot and fees should be received within the week of registering online**. After **March 1st**, all registration forms will be processed daily.

How do you decide who gets into a camp?

All registrations are processed on any one day (but not before **March 1st**) whether by mail, in person or by the Web based form.

Will I get a registration confirmation?

Yes. We will e-mail the camp selection confirmations within two weeks. **It is important to print your email clearly!**

Who do I pay?

Please make your checks payable to **Imagine That Summer Camp**. All camp charges are normally paid in full at the time of registration. **Payment for email registrations should be received within the week of registering. A payment plan is available upon request: contact Bev for details.**

Can I get a refund?

The seasonal nature of the Camp precludes any refund, or reduction for late or non-arrival, early withdrawal or student cancellation for any cause. Students sent home in violation of our rules, for medical reasons, or at the discretion of the family, or Imagine That! Summer Camp staff will receive no refund. However, camps which do not meet minimum enrollment will be cancelled and fees refunded.

What if my child's camp is filled by the time you receive the registration?

We ask if you have a 1st & 2nd choice, that you list both for each session that you enroll. **We will e-mail you to confirm the camp. Please make sure that your email address is clearly written.**

What if I want my child to be with a friend?

We try to honor friend requests. **To ensure that they are together**, send both registrations in the same envelope (email both together). **Be sure to put friend's name request on camp info. If received separately, we cannot hold a spot for the friend.**

How do I know the room number of my child's camp?

During the last week in May, a campus **map** and parent letter will be sent out to you via **email** as well as **camp room assignments**. Camp room assignments will also be posted at camp.

Is there early care available for the 6 weeks of camp?

No, but we do offer one hour classes for those who want a jump start on their day from 8-9:00.

If I sign up for lunchbunch, will a hot lunch be provided?

No, but there is an optional lunchbunch program available for one hour for a nominal charge where campers **bring a sack lunch** and eat with morning camp friends. Due to numerous nut allergies, **no peanut butter or nuts please!!!**

Age: Campers **MUST** be potty-trained and turn three by June

Cost: \$275.00

6 weeks of activities, why not join us for all 6 weeks! We will learn about ocean animals, jungle animals, bears, dinosaurs, bugs and our own native Arizona animals. We will immerse ourselves in messy animal art activities, learn all about specific animals and their habitats, move and play like animals, and even have some fun exploring the science of real animals like fish, hermie, octopus and cooking projects such as our jello aquarium. Yum! Camp is taught by Barbara Williams, creative movement/preschool teacher/Assistant Director from Chaparral Christian Preschool. Session 1, Barb will co teach with her daughter, Stephanie Williams, who has taught preschool for 10 years and has a fine arts and dance background. For session 2, Barb's partner is Sari Shanks, who is a 4's teacher, for the past 12 years, at Chaparral Christian Preschool.

6 weeks of activities, so why not sign up for all 6 weeks! Three-year-old campers will explore art, science and literature activities based on the classic stories of beloved author Eric Carle. Watch as we "bring alive" some of his most celebrated stories. Reading Carle's 10 *Little Rubber Ducks* will find us decorating our own ducks and floating them in canals we've dug on our playground. We'll experiment with sink/float activities and create our own "ocean waves" in a bottle. And what fun it will be painting our own caterpillar as we play with plastic insects and dirt in our messy table after reading *The Hungry Caterpillar*! Jenni Torres and Shannon Polk, both from Chaparral Christian Preschool are scheduled for Session 1. Session 2 is led by Cilla Neri from Chaparral Christian and Chelsey Boyle, Chaparral Christian substitute teacher. Jenni, Shannon and Cilla are degreed and have several years' experience with children. Chelsey is currently working on her degree and helping when needed at Chaparral. We are excited to have Jenni, Shannon and Chelsey returning to camp and welcome Cilla!

COUNT ON COOKING

Session: I & II
Age: Campers **MUST** be 4 by June
Cost: \$275.00 per session

6 weeks of activities with Teacher Diane, Teacher Julie and Teacher Amanda. Come join our classroom where kids learn the basics of cooking and have a whole lot of fun. We will explore how mathematics, science, literature and art are incorporated into cooking to create yummy treats. Mix a dash of science and you create *Thunder Cake* or read the tale of *Seven Silly Eaters* and bake banana bread with homemade butter! Or read *The Very Hungry Caterpillar* and create fruit pizza! Both sessions are filled with stories galore, brought to life in science, art and cooking activities! What fun! Teacher Diane O'Connell teaches in the Jr. Kindergarten program at PVUMC preschool as well as offers a very popular afterschool cooking enrichment class. Teacher Julie George, is a past PVUMC and current Pinnacle Presbyterian Preschool teacher and Amanda McDaniel is a past elementary teacher and current preschool teacher from Kyrene School District.

CREEPY CRAWLIES: A S.T.E.A.M. APPROACH TO THINGS THAT CREEP

Session: I only
Age: 5 & 6-year-old Campers
Cost: \$275.00

You'll split your time between **exploring the world of things that creep and cooking up some yummy bug bait or worm grub**. Part of your day will be spent looking at **insects, worms, hermit crab and other creepy crawlies** as you **create habitats with blocks, rocks, sand and dirt**. You might have to figure out what kind of maze Hermie will want to exercise in as you build with magnatiles on a large oil pan. Wonder whether worms like dark or light? Or wet or dry places to live? Investigating, hypothesizing, and team work are needed to create homes for these special animals that creep! You may also create some yummy **"bug bait"** and study these critters, their life cycle and read some **"buggy" books** for fun. Frank, the leopard gecko may make a visit too. **Sari Shanks, 4's teacher from Chaparral Christian Preschool is the lead for this camp full of exploration, problem solving and fun!**



DINOSAURS: A S.T.E. A. M. APPROACH

Session: II: Dinosaurs and Paleontology
Age: 5 & 6-year-old Campers
Cost: \$275.00 per session

Teaching STE(A)M through Dinosaurs: We will begin to integrate **Science, Technology, Engineering, (Art), and Math -STE(A)M** as we create our **dig** and make a **blueprint** of where our dinosaur bones might be. With discussions of **carnivores, herbivores and omnivores**, campers will participate in fun and engaging hands on activities to begin to develop higher level thinking skills, cooperative learning, and promote imagination/self-expression. **We'll dig for bones and hypothesize why the dinosaurs are extinct. What fun we will have exploding volcanos, finding out who eats who in the food chain** all while learning dino facts, building habitats and learning through play with puzzles, games and giant dinos! We will **compare sizes of dinosaurs to humans** and to the size of a dinosaur's footprint to a child's footprint. I wonder how many kid footprints or shoes can fit into a dinosaur footprint? We'll be busy using toilet paper and paper towel tubes to create a floor sized **dinosaur** as well as making our own dinosaur using craft foam geometric shapes. We will also **make our own fossils and hatch (baking soda) dinosaur eggs as a STEAM chemistry activity**. Come join us for this messy but fun camp. Former **S.U.S.D. teachers Nancy Smith and Jeanne Foster** are the Head Investigators.

FAIRY TALES: A S.T.E.A.M. APPROACH

Session: I Only
Age: 5 & 6-year-old Campers
Cost: \$275.00 per session

Full S.T.E.A.M. ahead to the Land of Fairytales! S.T.E.A.M. is the current acronym for Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math. Using various fairytales as the base, campers will have fun exploring hands on "S.T.E.A.M." activities to foster creative play, promote imagination, and develop problem solving skills. Activities will include: building and testing towers, bridges, rafts/boats, and parachutes to rescue fairytale characters; creating art projects and retelling stories through play; and finding solutions to "What if" questions to the fairytales we visit. All of this will be done in a fun, cooperative learning environment. Using the fairy tale, Jack and the Beanstalk, campers will design and create the tallest beanstalk that will support the most weight. This will involve measurement and weight. In addition, they will dissect a bean to investigate the parts of a bean and plant a bean to watch it grow. And, of course, they use their imagination as they create an art project around Jack and his beanstalk. Former SUSD Teachers, Nancy Smith and Jeanne Foster, lead this camp.

GREAT AMERICAN ARTISTS

(6 weeks of fun! Love art and science? Why not do both sessions? Each 3 weeks are unique.)

Session: I and II
Age: 5 & 6-year-old Campers
Cost: \$275.00 per session

This class will discover, by using hands-on art experiences, the styles of great American masters from the colonial times to the present. Each day each activity presents a biography with full color art work and techniques covering painting, drawing, sculpture, architecture, clay shaping and much more!! We'll create art pieces using the art processes of Louis Tiffany/Stain glass windows, Dale Chuly/Pool spheres, Grant Wood/Gothic paste-up, Gutzon Borglum/Carved clay blocks and Andy Warhol/Package design Pop art and more! Each session is different. Science, literature, music and making interesting mixtures to explore are part of this very messy camp. Karen Bakken is one of our resident artists. She has a bachelor's in education degree and has taught several years at PVUMC preschool as well as is currently offering an afterschool enrichment art program there.

KITCHEN TALES

Age: 5 & 6-year-old Campers

If you love cooking and eating as well as great stories, you are going to love this camp! We'll **begin with a story** and then we'll create a morning of fun-filled activities tied to the book of the day. There will be **measuring, pouring, stirring** and lots of tasting! Campers will use **math skills** and **create art projects** while their tasty treats bake. Each camper will get a **Camp Cookbook** to take home with them at the end of the session, as well as their **own apron, designed and decorated** by the mini-chef! If you're looking for a camp class to satisfy minds and tummies, this is the camp for you! **Messy art, creative games, cooking, eating activities** and **good literature** will center around children's classics. Teachers **Sandra Richardson, 2nd grade teacher from S.U.S.D. and Amanda McDaniel, past elementary and current preschool teacher from Kyrene School District, will be your head chefs for these two yummy camps! (12 campers max in each camp)**


